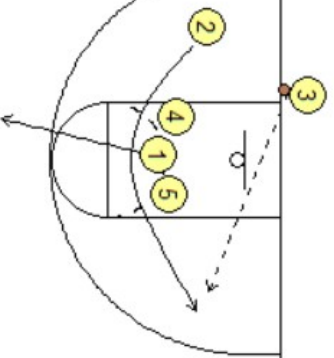


Out-of-Bounds Play "Baylor"

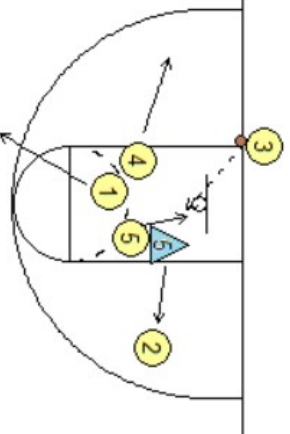
I saw Baylor coach Kim Mulkey run a play similar to this in the NCAA Final game vs Notre Dame. Your best shooter O2 starts on the ballside (diagram 1). O4, O1, and O5 are lined up across the paint. O2 cuts around the triple-screen for the pass and short jump-shot. After O2 cuts, O1 pops out to the top.

After running the play a couple times, the defense may cheat and X5 may switch and jump out to defend O2. Here, O5 seals and

steps in for the quick pass for a lay-up (diagram 2).
